In case you use a POP3 account you need to use the SMTP server of your internet service provider you use to connect to your internet (via modem, cable, ISDN, ADSL ...).

- Your internet provider is Telenet: use **smtp.telenet.be**
- Your internet provider is Belgacom: use **relay.skynet.be**
- Your internet provider is another company: contact your internet provider for more information
